2.4.2.1 The categories of members (see NOTE 1) used for consideration of balance shall be as follows:

- (1) Producers of the process or product to be standardized.      (2) Consumers of the process or product to be standardized.
- (3) General Interest members who represent concerns of the general public for the product or process to be standardized.

NOTE 1: Examples of Classification of Members. Producers would include the representatives of manufactures, distributors, developers, contractors and subcontractors, construction labor organizations, associations of these groups and professional consultants to these groups; Consumers would include representatives of owners, owners' organizations, designers and consultants retained by owners, testing laboratories retained by owners, and insurance companies serving owners; General Interest members would include researchers from private, state and federal organizations, representatives of public interest groups, representatives of consumer organizations, and representatives of standards and model code organizations. Regulators may form a special subclass of the General Interest category when the standard is intended for Regulatory purposes. Regulators would include representatives of regulatory organizations at local, state, or federal levels of government.
